

NOTES:

- 1. All construction shall conform to the City of Elk River standards for construction.
- 2. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to notify all utility owners of his construction schedule, and to protect all existing utilities from damage.
- 3. The Contractor shall take the necessary precautions to protect the public and employees from injury by open excavations or other hazardous circumstances by providing temporary fences, barricades, warning signs, flashers, and other safety devices.
- 4. The materials used in this work shall be new, conforming with the requirements of the referenced specifications for class, kind, type, size, and grade of material as specified below and other details indicated in the contract.
- 5. The Contractor shall restore those disturbed bituminous areas of Main Street. This work shall include straight line cutting of the designated area, removal, tacking of the edges, and restoration of each area to the existing section. All soil installed below pipe grades and around manholes shall be 100% compacted.


